Workshop Materials List:

Three canvases - size 12 x 16

Brushes - Bring what you use. Include some flats in sizes 6, 8 and 12 .

Also bring a small round size 4 or 6

Artist Quality oil paint such as Gamblin, Windsor Newton, Old Holland, Rembrandt, or Vasari

- Paint Colors : Bring two different Yellows, two different Reds and two different Blues, Plus a tube of White and one BONUS color of your choice. TOTAL of 8 tubes different colors. The idea is that we will use a warm and cool of each of the primaries, white and a personal color of your choice. Don't worry about knowing if the colors you choose are warm or cool. We will be discussing color temperature in class.

- Example of color choices : Radiant White Gamblin (or comparable in other brand), CAD Yellow Light, CAD Orange, Naphthol Scarlet, Alizarin Crimson Permanent, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue Hue PLUS. One of any other color you want to bring. TOTAL of 8 tubes of paint 150 ml.

GAMSOL: 33.8 oz bottle

(NO turpentine or turpentine products, no spirits or any solvent that is hazardous or has a scent. We will be using GAMSOL only)

GAMBLIN Solvent free gel 150 ml.

Paper towels, cotton cloth, a pack of facial wipes (I use costco brand)

Two small clean jars (like jelly jars) for the GAMSOL. (Some of you may already have stainless cups. Key is that you have something with a lid for your solvent)

Bottle water for drinking

A dry painting of yours that is either studio or plein air - that is 12 x 16 in size.
